### OBJECTIVES/FACILITIES

1. Formulation of Joint Business Council with the respective countries as holding meetings with them.
2. To facilitate the members in identifying new areas for possible economic cooperation.
3. To facilitate the members in identifying new areas for joint ventures possibilities.
4. To facilitate the members in marketing access to the respective countries.
5. To serve as advisory body to its members
6. To facilitate members in promotion of bilateral trade and economic relations with respective countries.
7. To assist members in the planning and organization of business meetings.
8. Lobbying support.
9. Participation in Trade Fairs and Exhibitions.
10. Visit of Trade delegation to respective countries.
11. To intensify interaction between the business communities of the two countries.
12. To play host to Trade Delegations from respective countries.
13. To keep a close liaison with the Chambers of Commerce and Industry, Embassies, Consulates and other concerned of the respective countries.

### ELIGIBILITY FOR THE MEMBERSHIP

1. Chief Executives, Managing Directors, Directors, Chairmen, Proprietors, Partners of Organizations, Companies, Firms can apply.
2. Applicant's company should have valid membership of any Chamber of Commerce & Industry or Association of Trade & Industry affiliated with FPCCI. Valid membership Certificate to be submitted.
3. Membership Form available on FPCCI's website or can be obtained on request.
4. The membership certificate for the Joint Chamber is for one calendar year against a membership fee of Rs. 6000/- only, whereas the Membership of Business Councils is for one calendar year against a membership fee Rs. 5000/- only.
5. Membership Fee may be made in the form of pay Order/Demand Draft favouring FPCCI at the earliest.
6. **The elections of all Business Councils are in process for the year 2015. Those members who have valid membership of these Business Councils will be eligible to participate in these Elections.**
7. **A Minimum of 20 valid members is required to hold the elections to the 9 members of the Board of Directors of each Business Council.**
