Owing to COVID - 19 crisis, the Government of Balochistan has already imposed ban on all types of religious procession vide this Department's NO.SO(Judl:)8(31)2020/1071-1091/dated 4th May, 2020. Moreover, the Federal Government has also directed all the Provincial Governments not to permit for any religious processions.

Therefore, all concerned are required to engage with Ulemas of 2. Ehl e Tashi and apprise them about the escalating ratio of COVID - 19 cases so that processions on Yaum e Ali could be avoided.

The matter may be treated as most important and urgent.

NO.SO(Judl:)8(31)2020/1100-1121/. In partial modification of this Department's order No.SO(Judl:)8(31)2020/1071-1091 dated 4th May, 2020, the Government of Balochistan is pleased to order as follows in Balochistan Province regarding "Lockdown":

- a. All Shopping malls, markets, shops/stores outlets, godowns, depots, autoworkshops will remain open from 0300 hours to 1700 hours throughout the week
 - All above malls, markets, shops/stores, outlets etc will shut down after 05.00 evening. In case of violation, legal action would be taken against the owners.
- b. Tandoor, shops/stores of dairy products, medical stores, blood banks and tailors will remain open 24 hours
- C. Restaurants/hotels will remain open 24 hours only for home delivery or take away service
- d. Rest of the restrictions/exemptions will remain intact till 19th May, 2020 as notified in above quoted order dated 4th May, 2020.

Conditions: -

The following preventive measures are required to be taken by business community and general public during their movement/shopping in malls/bazars and markets: -

- Sufficient sanitizer and hand-wash for workers and customers/general public at work places/markets, shops etc be placed
- Use of masks, gloves will be mandatory for shop owners/workers as well as ii. for the customers during operations/work or shopping
- No customer will be allowed inside the shop without mask 111.
- At least one meter distance between all workers/staff and customer/general iv. pubic is to be kept
- Not more than four (04) persons would be allowed at a time in a shop V.
- Use of water and soap, to wash hands, be ensured VI.
- All other general instructions regarding COVID 19 be followed in letter vii. and spirit
- This order shall remain in force in the entire Province of Balochistan with 2. immediate effect till 1200 noon, 19th May, 2020 unless modified.
- This order shall be given wider publicity in official Gazette, Daily Newspapers 3. and broadcasting through Radio Pakistan, Pakistan Television and other Print/Electronic media for information of the general public.

NOTIFICATION

No.SO(Admn)RR&SD/2-49/2020: In continuation of this Department Notification of even No. dated 15th April, 2020, the advice received from Federal Government, for the convenience of the public, and in conjunction with the emergency regarding COVID-19, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is pleased to order the following:

- i. In phase-II of the exemption of Construction activities, businesses of steel and PVC Pipes, electric appliances, manufacturers of steel & aluminum equipment, ceramic and paints industries, sanitary, paints, steel and aluminum works and hardware stores are hereby exempted from closure subject to the adaptation of SOPs / guidelines already issued for Industrial units and sale points. Moreover the aforementioned shall remain open for 4 days in a week and not later than 4:00 PM in the day and shall be closed on Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays.
- All factories which are not included in negative lists of factories are allowed to resume their operations. However detailed notification with regard to industrial units shall be issued by the Industries Department.
- iii. All shops are allowed to remain open for 4 days in a week but not later than 4:00 PM in the day subject to adaptation of SOPs. However, these will remain closed on Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays except the already identified essential ones.
- iv. For the resumptions of public passenger transport, meetings will be held with the representatives of transporters at Provincial and divisional level to prepare proper SOPs for operationalization of transport sector.

NO. E&A (Health)/2-264/2020. The Competent Authority in Health Department is pleased to notify the following Revised Policy on Testing for COVID-19:

Revised Policy on Testing for COVID-19

Over the last 45 days, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has built up testing capacity from scratch to around 1500 tests per day. With the on-boarding of several private sector providers to assist the Government, these capacities will more than double by the beginning of May.

To more successfully manage the spread of the disease, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Government intends to use this capacity, by rapidly scaling up testing. Until now, testing has focused on symptomatic patients and travelers, in accordance with the National Policy, but with the spread of the disease, this limited selection of whom to test is not sufficient.

In short, we need to test more.

The Government will therefore periodically issue guidelines to scale up the level of testing. In the very-short term, within May, we intend to double the number of tests conducted, to over 2000 per day, by testing more contacts. Beyond May, we may aggressively rump up to a much larger number of tests, between 5000 and 10,000 per day, once logistics are worked out.

The guidelines below, which may be periodically updated, should serve as a guide for whom to test within districts.

Healthcare& Frontline Workers: Any Healthcare worker or any other front line
personnel involved in the COVID-19 response in any capacity deemed to be at risk from
the disease, either through close contact with COVID-19 patient (even without
symptoms), or with COVID-19 symptoms. These individuals will be the first priority for
COVID-19 testing, and shall not be denied a test. Samples should be tagged II.

2. Contacts of a COVID19 Patient:

- a. Household contacts: If there are less than 5 members in the house the testing protocol is to test all of them. If there are more than 5 members, test the 5 ones who are at the higher age side or with co morbidities and must be tagged as CT1 samples (Annexure).
- b. Outside Home/Household Contacts: All close contacts that satisfy the definition of a close contact (Annexure) should be tested and shall be labeled as CT 2.
- c. Institutional Screening: If a positive case has been reported within an institution, the policy implies that whoever within the organization is deemed at risk must be tested and shall be labeled as CT 3.
- Community Based Surveillance Sampling: If community based surveillance (i.e.
 people within the vicinity of a case, but without known contact history) in an area
 with a known case or known cases is deemed necessary, a community based
 surveillance campaign may be carried out, and samples shall be tagged as CS 1for
 further testing.
- Public Dealing Personnel: Any person with suggestive symptoms who is engaged in public dealing e.g. shopkeepers, bank tellers, transport service employees, Law Enforcing Agencies personnel should be tested. Tag as P.

- Pneumonia: Person with pneumonia of unknown actiology should be tested. Tag as
- Unexplained Deaths: Sampling of all the unexplained deaths is preferred for the purpose of further surveillance and disease spread control. Tag as D
- Any other list shared by Provincial/National authorities for testing shall be tested.
 Tag as CS 2
- Any person referred by a Physician/Specialist/Consultant based on clinical grounds should be tested. Tag as C
- For in bound flights passengers, all passengers should be tested after 48 hours of landing and tagged as E.
- For all follow up testing for clearance of an already confirmed COVID-19 Patient tag as R.


