The Developing Eight (D-8) is an organization for economic cooperation and was created in 1997 through the Istanbul Declaration of Summit of Heads of State/Government.

The objective of this organization is to improve member states' position in the global economy, diversify and create new opportunities in trade relations, enhance participation in decision-making at international level, and improve standards of living.

The composition of D-8 reflects a global arrangement from South East Asia to Africa; consists of eight developing countries.

Objective

To commemorate Silver Jubilee of D-8 by D-8 Chambers of Commerce and Industries (D-8 CCI), a Business Forum and Expo was organized by D-8 CCI at Dhaka, Bangladesh on 25 – 27 July 2022.

Welcome Dinner

Mr. Sheikh Fazle Fahim, President D-8 Chambers of Commerce and Industries (D-8 CCI) hosted Welcome Dinner in honor of the visiting delegations. Mr. Mr. Irfan Iqbal Sheikh, President FPCCI met all the delegates present there and discussed prevailing economic situation with heads of the delegations. He invited head of each delegation to visit Pakistan along with a trade delegation for promotion of trade and investment. He offered to host and arrange B2B meetings for the trade delegations for achieving the optimum result from their visit to Pakistan.









Opening Ceremony of D-8 Business Forum & General Assembly

The D-8 conference opened with Welcome Speech by Sheikh Fazle Fahim, President of D-8 CCI, followed by speeches by heads of each delegation,









Speech by Mr. Irfan Iqbal Sheikh, President FPCCI

In his address, Mr. Irfan Iqbal Sheikh, President FPCCI said that the intra-regional trade among D-8 countries is currently 4.5 percent average, despite the fact that all countries have signed preferential trade agreement in 2016 and decided to enhance intra-regional trade to US\$ 500 billion in 2018. The Preferential Trade Agreement (PTA) is still not implemented due to incomplete internal procedures and lack of customs notifications. Thus far, only Malaysia and Turkey have completed their internal procedures. Other countries should come forward and complete all the requirements for the implementation. He also informed that D-8 countries are major travel destinations, some of them offering all-year round tourism services.

On behalf of Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FPCCI), he also congratulated President D-8 Chamber of Commerce and Industry Sheikh Fazle Fahim and his team for organizing celebration of D-8 CCI Silver Jubilee and other activities in Dhaka, Bangladesh.







H.E. Ambassador Isiaka Abdulqadir Imam, Secretary General D-8 Secretariat and Mr. Salman Fazlur Rahman, Advisor to Prime Minister, H.E. Md. Shahriar Alam, State Minister of Foreign Affairs, H.E. Tipu Munshi, Minister of Commerce graced the occasion and addressed the Conference.

Representatives from Egypt, Iran, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Turkey and Bangladesh under the banner of D-8, or developing eight countries discussed a number of proposals for expanding trade among D-8 countries. Bangladesh's Foreign Minister A.K. Abdul Momen said the group, with a \$5 trillion economy among its members, was working to implement a free trade agreement while also increasing the volume of trade. The event was attended by over 40 delegates from across the eight D-8 member countries.



The Business Forum session started after a sumptuous Lunch and concluded with a Joint Declaration.

The Business Forum focused towards creating a strategic roadmap that will enable Value Chain Integration between D-8 member nations and propagate exponential economic and trade growth for all nations.

As a response to economic uncertainties and risks arising from the fallout of the covid-19 pandemic and key global developments, the D-8 CCI is developing a strategic roadmap, for PTA ratification and engagement in value chain integration across the agriculture, manufacturing, tertiary and quaternary sectors. Key aspects of the proposal include:

- Employing value chain integration in the long run to mitigate supply chain volatility with pegged price guarantees and ensure secured livelihood, employment and investment
- Alternative trade finance and trade facilitation processes such as cross currency swap, barter and blockchain to address foreign currency reserve vulnerabilities
- Unified standardization and harmonization of processes to address non-tariff barriers
- Easing the D8 visa regime for entrepreneurs to assist with greater connectivity within the D8 private sectors, contributing towards greater intra D8 trade and flow of investments.
- Mapping contingencies for the D8 Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (D8CECA) to assist in long term D8 value chain integration, mitigating risks contributing towards global stagflation
- Enabling technologies such as Cybersecurity, 4IR, IOT, AI, Data Analytics and Industrial IOT across economic sectors.
- Sustainability, circular economy, she-trades, MSMEs, start-up ecosystem, Innovation, Green Technology, Climate Change and Blue Economy also identified as priority areas for implementing value chain integration





The roadmap and its strategies were discussed during the General Assembly on Day 1 of the event and presented to the ministerial meeting on Day 2, subsequently being proposed to the trade and commerce ministries from respective countries, after the event.







Cultural Show and Dinner

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs Bangladesh hosted a Cultural Show and Dinner in honor of the visiting delegations at Hotel Intercontinental, Dhaka. The delegates enjoyed marvelous performances from several countries.









Ministerial Meeting

Ministerial Meeting was held at Hotel Intercontinental Dhaka. Honorable Sheikh Hasina, the Prime Minister of Bangladesh addressed the meeting via video link and stressed the need for implementing the PTA within the Grouping to make it a strong economic bloc. She urged member countries to work together to provide the impetus for harnessing the potential towards a prosperous future. Honourable Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina expressed her satisfaction with the finalization of D-8 PTA which she hoped would help harmonize intra-country trade, liberalize the barriers, and stimulate trade and economic cooperation among the member states.

Aside the issue of trade, other key issues deliberated on by the meetings included administrative and financial matters and the issue of enlargement objectives of the Organization, as well as the current and future activities of the five D-8 affiliate bodies, namely, the D-8 Health and Social Protection Program, D-8 Technology Transfer and Exchange Network, D-8 International University, D-8 Network of Pioneers for Research and Innovation and D-8 Agricultural Research centres. Sheikh Fazle Fahim, President of D-8 CCI submitted Joint Declaration at the beginning of the Ministerial Meeting.


